Food Truck Season Will be Coming Soon... Are you Prepared?

Are you interested in operating a food truck (Mobile Cooking Operation) within the Town of Taber? Have questions about licensing, inspections, and where food trucks are allowed to operate?

You will need the following (at minimum, this is not an exhaustive list) if you're planning to operate a Food Truck in Taber:

- Town of Taber Business License
- Fire Inspection by the Taber Fire Department
- Health Inspection from Alberta Health Services
- Development Permit from the Town (if the truck will be stored at your residence; not required for non-Town residents)

Though the list seems like a lot, our staff will work with you to make it easy! Applying as soon as possible will give enough time for the processes and approvals to go through before spring arrives.

If you want to know where Food Trucks are allowed to park in Taber, you are always welcome to give our Planning & Economic Development staff a call (or email planning @taber.ca) and they will be happy to help.

Monthly Energy Management Tip

Residential Heating Equipment – Gas Fired Furnace

Canada's cold climate means that space heating accounts for a remarkable 63% of the energy used in the average Canadian home. A well-maintained furnace can last between 15 to 30 years.

According to Fortis BC, standard efficiency furnaces installed in homes before 1990 were as little as 60% efficient. Common natural gas furnaces installed in homes built between 1990 and 2010 were slightly better at 80% efficient. That means, even if it was installed correctly and well maintained, 20 cents of every dollar spent

heating your home may be lost through exhaust. Do you currently have an aging furnace that is close or past it's useful life? Nowadays, all furnaces sold in Canada are required to be 90% or higher efficient, with some furnaces rated for 98.5% efficiency. Upgrading an aging furnace to an ENERGY STAR certified, forced air, gas-fired furnace that has an annual fuel utilization efficiency (AFUE) of 96% can reduce your heating bill by as much as 38%.

Upgrading your old furnace (heating equipment) will extend the life if your HVAC system, reduce the overall size of a new furnace, and reduce your energy bill. It's a win-win-win!

Monthly Emergency Preparedness Tips: Flooding

February might seem a little early to be considering flood preparedness, but with the unpredictability of a Southern Alberta spring and snow melt, it's always a good idea to be prepared well in advance. Do you know how to keep your family and home safe if flooding happens? Here are some tips for both:

Protect your Home & Belongings

- Use weather protection sealant around basement windows and the base of ground-level doors
- ♦ Ensure downspout drainage moves water away from the property (point them away from the house foundation. But be careful not to point them at your neighbour's property)
- ♦ Install a sump pump and zero reverse flow valves in basement floor drains if possible
- Consult your electricity or fuel supplier on how to protect our electrical, natural gas or propane equipment in case of flooding
- ♦ Do not shut off electricity if any water is present
- Remove toxic substances such as pesticides or insecticides from the flood area to prevent pollution
- ♦ Know your home insurance policy in relation to flooding and flood damage

Protect your Family

- ♦ In case of flooding, be prepared to evacuate at a moment's notice. Plan ahead by making emergency kits & keeping important documents and valuables in an easy-to-access location
- Stock up on supplies and store them in an aboveground location
- ♦ Store important documents in a waterproof place
- ♦ NEVER attempt to cross a flooded area
 - If you are caught in fast-rising waters and your vehicle stalls, abandon the car to save yourself and your passengers
 - Avoid low-lying areas such as ravines or underpasses that can flood quickly
