Monthly Emergency Preparedness Tips: Financial Preparedness

We all know we should prepare for various emergencies and hazards with kits, plans, and responses. But did you know you should also be prepared financially for the same? As tax season approaches, many are looking at their finances, and emergency preparedness should be one of those considerations. Being financially prepared is about more than just having money in the bank. Having the right insurance for your property and belongings can reduce financial hardship and your recovery time after an emergency. Here are some various finance tips to be prepared:

Insurance

- Ensure you have adequate insurance for your property and keep a detailed list of all property (include photographs)
 - The Insurance Bureau of Canada has a superhelpful Personal Property Inventory Checklist that you can use to go room-by-room to inventory your property: http://www.ibc.ca/ mb/home/risk-management/home-inventory
- Educate yourself on what your insurance policy will and will not cover, the policy limits, and what the different coverages may be for different types of emergencies. Ask your agent questions

Keep Cash on Hand

- ♦ Emergencies may cause internet, banking, or ATM services to go down. Keep cash on hand in case you need it in an emergency
- ♦ Keep different levels of bills (\$5, \$10, \$20, etc) and some coins on hand

Emergency Savings Account

♦ If possible, consider creating an emergency savings account to cover expenses during an emergency. Even \$5/month will add up over time

Keep Receipts

- ♦ In an emergency, keep all receipts for any expenses incurred
- Receipts may be needed for insurance claims or other disaster recovery programs

Make Emergency Preparedness Affordable

- ♦ Affordability can be a barrier for emergency preparedness, but you don't have to let it get in your way of getting started. You can create great emergency kits using items from dollar stores, and even items you have already in your home. Here are some affordable options for creating emergency kits:
 - ♦ A backpack, suitcase, or 10-gallon pail you already have to use as an emergency kit
 - ♦ Extra clothing from thrift stores (i.e.: mitts, hats, and scarves for winter kits, etc.)
 - Dollar store items (bandages, canned food, small tools, candles, flashlights, batteries, etc.)
 - ♦ Items already in your house (water bottles, toilet paper, garbage bags, etc.)

If Money is Still an Issue

If money or time is still an issue, create a list of things you cannot live without. Critical thinking during a time of stress is challenging. Having a list that you follow to quickly grab and go will help. What supplies would you gather?
