

A Quick Guide to the Town of Taber's Water Conservation Restriction Levels









NO RESTRICTIONS-ALL WATER USES ALLOWED

Normal water levels.

This is the normal, everyday state of water usage in Taber. There are no restrictions.

MOST WATER USES PERMITTED

Outdoor water use is permitted three days per week based on house address, no restrictions on types of outdoor water uses (ie: pools, washing cars, etc.) on prescribed days.*

*Watering lawns, gardens, trees & shrubs limited to specific hours to reduce evaporation

MANDATORY WATERING RESTRICTIONS

All outdoor water use is restricted to two days per week based on house address, and only during prescribed times.

EMERGENCY WATER RESTRICTIONS

Most severe level.

Level reserved for emergency & extreme drought situations.

All outdoor water uses & non-essential water usage is prohibited.

*FOR MORE DETAILS & EXEMPTIONS

- Further details are provided in the Town's Water Conservation Bylaw, including what types of outdoor water use activities are allowed in each Restriction Level and which uses have exemptions. View the bylaw at www.taber.ca/bylaws.
- Gardens used for growing food are exempt from restrictions in Levels I & II, but must only be watered during prescribed times (Level II also restricts to handwatering only). Gardens are not exempt in Level III restrictions.
- Household water use is not restricted under any level, though water conservation measures are encouraged at any level of restriction.
