Meeting Date: January 14, 2015 Item 5. (A)						
Subject: Helmet Requirement	nts for Public Skating					
Recommendation:	That the Recreation Board review at Councils request the helmet requirements for public skating and make a recommendation to Council.					
Background:	Council at their regular meeting held January 12, 2015 reviewed the helmet requirements for public skating. Members of Council felt the rule was not user friendly for the public and requested that the Recreation Board review the rule once again in a special meeting and make a recommendation to Council for the January 26, 2015 meeting.					
Legislation / Authority:	MGA s. 3, Municipal Purposes					
Strategic Plan Alignment:	No strong alignment					
Financial Implication:	There would be a small cost to change language on the arena rules signage.					
Service Level / Staff Resource Implication:	No significant impact.					
Justification:	Originally the ruling for helmet requirements was 12 and under. After watching people that use the ice fall and the growing evidence that concussions have long term effects on people's health, the staff requested the rule change.					
Alternative(s):	The Recreation Board may choose to recommend to Council that they have no requirement for helmets for any age group as currently set in the interim by Council or may choose an alternative requirements of helmets for those of a certain age category (e.g. 12 & under, 16 and under, under 18, etc.).
