DELEGATIONS

A) Taber Museum

A member from the Taber Museum supplied the Recreation Board with 2013 event programs and budget and discussed their event and the waiver request. The event was a success and the Taber Museum is asking for a similar waiver for 2014. This is their only fundraiser and makes a profit of about \$1000.00 which is used for operating costs.

The Recreation Board thanked the representative and commended the museum for their great event.

B) Taber Food Bank

Two representatives from the Taber Food Bank were on hand to request their dinner event rental to be waivered for 2014. The event has been very successful in the past and all profits go to the local food bank operations.

The Recreation Board thanked the Taber Food Bank for all they do for the less fortunate in the community.

C) Terry Fox Run

A representative from the Terry Fox Run committee in the Town of Taber was on hand to answer any questions the Recreation Board had regarding their request for waiver for 2014. She also explained that the event does not have a budget and whatever money comes in goes directly to the Terry Fox Foundation. Since the event has been moved indoors the event has grown three fold and the Town of Taber is in the top five fundraisers in all of Alberta and would like to keep the event at the Auditorium again for 2014.

The Recreation Board thanked the Terry Fox Committee for all they do in the fight against cancer and felt much of Taber's success is due to Yvonne's heart and hard work and commended her efforts.

A) 2013 Southern Alberta Summer Games Update

A. Holmen reported the Southern Alberta Summer Games planning is on track. All the sports chairs are or will filled soon.

Coordinator position is being filled by Kayla Beers and she will begin Apr 24th. In the mean time Dwight Holmen is filling in and helping with data entry and such. Volunteers can sign up on line which is exciting and the athletes will start registering at the beginning of May.

Some equipment is required and most will be for the Athletics due to old existing equipment. Some of the funding normally utilized for games has been cut i.e. STEP Grant. The Development Initiative Program was also cut from the Provincial Budget and was a grant that organizations normally applied to for games equipment funding. Fundraising signage will start to go up May 1st at the administration building.

MD of Taber is fixing their existing beach volleyball court at the MD of Taber Park and will be installing a new one at the MD Park. This will be a great venue for the games.

A. Holmen informed the Recreation Board that the Taber Parade will be during the Summer Games and the logistics are still being decided.
