CALL TO ORDER

Luke Wijna called the Regular Meeting of the Taber Recreation Board to order at 5:17 pm

ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

RES. 37/2013 MOVED by G. Simmons to adopt the agenda as presented.

DELEGATIONS

A) St. Mary's High School

St. Mary's Vice Principal was present to answer any questions the Recreation Board had regarding their waiver request for 2014 Graduation to be held June 25-28. The event is too large to be held in the school and the school is grateful of their partnership they have had with the town for past decades and wish to continue the partnership.

The Recreation Board thanked the gentleman for attending.

B) W.R Myer's High School

The Principal from W.R. Myer's was present to answer any questions the Recreation Board had regarding their request for their facility waiver for

the school's 2014 Graduation. She explained that with around 1000 people attending, the Large Ice arena is the only facility able to accommodate. She explains that although the existing waivers have covered 4 days of their event, they actually pay for additional time in the large ice and rent the Auditorium for the day of graduation. She too expressed gratitude to the town for their continued partnership with the school in helping make the event extra special event for the attendants.

The Recreation Board thanked her for attending.

A) Regular meeting – May 2, 2013

A) Sponsorship Update

A. Holmen reported that the sponsorship program is still quite active however is running into barriers with companies restructuring or changing of personnel. The Recreation Board expressed disappointment with the amount of progress and had hoped to be further along by this point.

B) 2013 Southern Alberta Summer Games Update

A. Holmen reported that the Southern Alberta Summer Games planning has hit a very busy point. Fundraising has been successful and is continuing. Brochures have been sent to the printers. Registration deadline is on Monday and at which point participant numbers will be known. Coordinators are running into a problem with lack of volunteers and are finding recruitment to be difficult. Volunteers are particularly needed in Athletics and for the 5/10 km run. A. Holmen expressed gratitude to her sport chairpersons for their continued effort and experience they bring forward from previous games.

C) Summer Leisure Guide/Programs

A. Holmen reported that the Summer Leisure Guides went to all the schools at the end of May. They have become very popular and people know when they usually come out and are looking for them. They can also be seen on the website in a PDF version. Eventually we would like to have them only on line.

The Recreation Board also discussed the renewed agreement with the Taber Kinsmen to again offer free youth swimming on Tuesday nights starting in June and continuing through until the end of August.

Canada Day celebrations are being planned again this year. It was questioned as to what the town does for Family Day and how it is advertised. A Holmen reported that up to this point there are usually no activities planned for Family Day.

RES. 41/2013 MOVED by Councilor R. Sparks that the Recreation Board accepts the 2013 Summer Leisure Guide as well as Canada Day information as presented.

D) Taber Recreation Board Meetings

A. Holmen responded to questions which arose in the previous meeting about when to go into "In Camera" sessions. It is appropriate to do so when the board is entering into discussions on "Land", "Legal", or "Labor" and it was agreed that last meetings discussions did have the potential to fall under "Legal". A reminder was given to try to keep the meetings as public as possible, however when necessary to enter into Closed Session it must be done so with a majority vote. The wording legality of the policy is still being looked into by administration.

A) St. Mary's School – Recreation Facility Rental Fee Waiver Application

The Recreation Board discussed the man hours spent preparing for events such as this and it was confirmed that all events within the Town of Taber facilities require maintenance to comply with building code. It was also noted that the application should read "Date(s) requested" rather than "Date of Function" to accommodate the request for multiple days.

This was in reference to liability of volunteers doing maintenance work on Town properties as volunteers. A. Holmen agreed to look into the rational behind these practices.

A concern was raised regarding the rusty condition of the KMMSC sign. The board was informed that there is a work order in place to deal with the rust. It was suggested that a picture be sent to the company that produced the sign so they are aware that their practice is not acceptable and see if they will rectify the situation.
