





- The skatepark is an unsupervised facility. The Town of Taber is not responsible for loss, injury or damage. USE AT YOUR OWN RISK
- Skateboards, BMX Bikes, and Rollerblades are permitted. BMX PEGS AND HANDLEBAR CAPS MUST BE USED
- Use of SAFETY EQUIPMENT such as helmets, gloves, knee pads and elbow pads, wrist support and proper support shoes is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED
- The park accommodates a variety of skill levels. PARTICIPATE WITHIN YOUR ABILITY and abide by skatepark etiquette
- · Children under the age of 10 should be supervised by an adult
- Wet or inclement weather increases the risk of injury. Do not use when wet, snowy or icy conditions exist
- The area should be kept free of debris-DON'T LITTER Garbages are available. No glass containers allowed
- BE RESPECTFUL OF THE PARK-no graffiti, homemade rails or other props
- First aid and telephones can be accessed at the Aquafun Centre

TOWN OF TABER OFF LEASH DOG PARK



Rules:

- Handlers are responsible for any injuries or damages caused by dogs under their control.
- 2. Handlers must clean up after dogs under their control
- The Town of Taber is not liable for damages or injury through miss-use or caused by patrons of the park
- 4. Dogs must be licensed and have full cycle, current vaccinations
- 5. Dogs must be older than 4 months
- 6. Dogs must be in view and under control of their owner at all times
- Handlers must have possession of a leash at all times, and on-leash outside the park
- 8. Dogs displaying aggressive tendencies must be muzzled or removed from the park
- 9. Handlers are limited to a maximum of 3 dogs at any one time
- 10.Female dogs in heat are prohibited

Bronze Medallion/ Bronze Cross with CPR-C



Bronze Medallion teaches an understanding of the lifesaving principles used for water rescue. Participants develop skills in preparation for challenging water rescues involving conscious and unconscious victims of various types. Participants work on stroke efficiency and complete timed swims.

Bronze Cross continues with more advanced lifesaving principles and skills as well as introduces safe supervision in aquatic facilities. The completion of Bronze Cross also earns the participant the CPR-C certificate. Bronze Cross is the prerequisite for all advanced training programs, including National Lifeguard and Lifesaving Instructor.

National Lifeguard - Pool Option



The primary role of the National Lifeguard is the prevention of emergency situations and the timely and effective resolution of emergencies. The National Lifeguard certification prepares lifeguards to fulfill this role as professional facilitators of safe, enjoyable aquatics in a pool setting.

The National Lifeguard program develops the basic lifeguarding skills, principles, and decision-making process to help lifeguards evaluate and adapt to different aquatic facilities and emergencies.

Pre-requisite: Bronze Cross, Standard First Aid and a minimum of 16 years of age.
