


 Bylaw 6-2017 to include

Summer Developments

This is the time of year for new decks, pergolas, garages, sheds, pools, etc. If you are planning of building something on your property and don't quite know where to start - you can either check our upgraded website for information or give us a call at 403-223-5500 ext. 5551.

TIPS:

- A fence does not need a permit as long as it is on or within your property line and remains under 6 feet tall in the back yard.
- A shed / deck does not need a permit as long as it is under 10 square meters or 108 square feet. However, even without permits you should still follow the setbacks for accessory uses which are as follows:
 - 0.6m from a property line not shared with a street
 - 1.2 meters from a property line shared with a street
 - 1.0 meters from the principal dwelling
 - only a maximum of 5 meters tall for sheds
 - any deck over 2 feet tall requires permitting
 - If it is over those dimensions, it is required

- All pergolas and garages require both building and development permits to ensure they are built to code and within the proper setbacks as per the land use bylaw.
- All pools require a development permit. Once they are submitted, a development officer will advise if you require a building permit or not.

Economic Growth

The Conference Board of Canada's Provincial Outlook: Spring 2017 report indicates Alberta and Saskatchewan to emerge out of recession and lead the provinces in economic growth this year. FRONT YARDS



We need to build examples and we need to spread the word!

How does the program work? We will work with you and a professional Rain Gardens 4 Resilience landscaper to make over a portion of your front yard by adding a rain garden and managing your downspouts. We will cover the basic cost of design and construction. Work needs to be completed in 2017.

What do you need to do? You agree to keep and maintain the project for at least 5 years, to allow the location and details of the project to be publicized, and to promote it to friends and neighbours.

What's in it for you? A more beautiful, low-maintenance garden, stronger ties to your community, and the satisfaction of doing your part to contribute to a more resilient urban landscape.

What is a rain garden? A rain garden is a shallow, planted depression that collects rain from downspouts, or from any area of concentrated flow—driveways, rain barrel overflows, etc. It holds back water from reaching the street, which reduces overland and downstream flooding and also improves water quality. It is also great habitat for Milkweed, which Monarch butterflies require to complete their life cycle.
