## World Town Planning Day November 8, 2017

The Taber Planning Department visited two schools on November 8th during World Town Planning Day to discuss what planning is, what planners do and have them participate in planning activities. DA Ferguson grade 6 social studies class participated in planning the Taber Trout Pond Project. St. Mary's grade 9 social studies class participated in planning Taber's Downtown.



Ideas the grade 6 classes had regarding Trout Pond:

- Bridge over the pond to get to the other side quickly
- Tackle/bait shop
- Rental shop for canoes, fishing rods, etc.
- history signs along the walking trail
- Costco (because you can buy canoes and kayaks there)
- sand beach



In the continuation of undertaking initiatives encouraging a vibrant downtown and creating conditions for business success and economic development in the community, Taber Economic Development (TED) has partnered with a student from

- dock

Building off this project, TED also partnered in a pilot project with some local home based businesses to open up a week long pop up shop in a vacant downtown store from (4702 52 Street) from December 13th to the 17th. There will be multiple businesses in one building selling anything from home décor, soaps, and signs, to jewelry, clothing and paintings. On Saturdat the 16th the pop up shop will host Santa Claus between 6-8pm while serving hot chocolate and cookies. # Town of Taber and MD of Tabe Beautification Program by Community Futures

Community Futures is offering the opportunity to receive a beautification loan and grant to enhance the appearance of a business. The program provides an incentive for local business owners to invest in façade renovations and interior upgrades. Businesses may be eligible to receive an interest free loan up to a maximum of \$8,000 along with a grant up to a maximum of \$2,000.

Financial support is available for Alberta's communities, regions and municipalities for initiatives that help promote long-term economic growth. The CARES program will run from 2016 to 2018 and fund initiatives that create a measurable impact and align with one or more of the following program outcomes:

- improving local business environment and/or regional economic collaboration
- increasing support for entrepreneurs and small- and medium-sized enterprises
   (SMEs) to grow and succeed
- enhancing support for businesses and industries that provide diversification to a community or a region
- increasing investment that drives high-value job creation.
