Purpose

The purpose of this procedure is to develop operating guidelines for the Slow Your Roll Signage policy.

Operating Guidelines

- 1) The "Slow Your Roll" campaign and signage shall be administered by the Coordinator and not any Town of Taber employee.
- 2) The Campaign Coordinator shall be contacted at 403-635-6471.
- 3) The Campaign Coordinator will be responsible for the distribution of the signage and the notification of all buyers as to the rules and regulations regarding the "Slow Your Roll" signage.
- 4) Should there be any changes to the Town's *Land Use Bylaw* or *Traffic Control Bylaw* that may impact this campaign, the Town of Taber shall notify the Campaign Coordinator as soon as possible.
- 5) Sign owners must remove the signage from the boulevards no more than thirty (30) minutes after children have finished playing in the area. The "Slow Your Roll" signage is intended by the campaign and their definition under the *Land Use Bylaw* to be temporary. Therefore, signage shall be permitted on boulevards when children are playing in the area, but must be removed after the children have concluded playing in the vicinity.



- 6) This Procedure provides authorization for citizens to place "Slow Your Roll" signage on boulevards as per the authority granted to the Chief Administrative Officer in the Traffic Control Bylaw 15-2019 in Section 17.03.
- 7) The signs must not hinder or obstruct sidewalks, driveways, or any roadways or become a hazard, hindrance, or debris. Should an obstruction or hindrance occur, the Town of Taber reserves the right as per Traffic Control Bylaw 15-2019 Section 17.03 b) to remove and dispose of the signage without any notice or warning to the owner thereof.
